The OCV Awards are your opportunity to get a massive amount of attention for yourself. So, get in your application. This awards program is open to all OCV members.

Awards are made to individuals, except for the *Web Site* award which is for an organisation.

Entering is easy. You can nominate yourself if you wish. Just fill out the form and provide a short essay of 700 words to support the application and supporting documentation. Entries close on 31 July 2008, with winners announced on Thursday 11 September 2008 at the Awards Dinner of the 2008 *CHU* OCV Principals Forum / Symposium – Regulatory Change: Post Implementation.

There are a number of different categories:

1. *CHU OCV Best owners corporation manager* [highest award]
2. *Whitbread Insurance Brokers OCV Small owners corporation manager* [eg SoHo & franchised managers, small OCs]
3. *Rigby Cooke Lawyers OCV Large owners corporation manager* [eg large managers, complex OCs]
4. *Tymaline Building Services OCV Specialist owners corporation manager* [eg niche/boutique managers – golf, resort, retirement]
5. *Buildcheck OCV Rising Star owners corporation manager* [eg new and/or inexperienced manager]
6. *Roscon OCV Web Site* [for best web site]

In subsequent years, there will also be available, if awarded, a *CHU OCV Fellow* [awarding of *CHU* FSM – Fellow Strata Manager]. Refer to OCV’s published criteria for further details.

- Nominations must be submitted by an OCV member.
- Nominees must be an OCV member who is financial.
- The submission must relate to activity occurring in the past year, although it may have been occurring for longer than the previous 12 months.
- You are able to enter yourself, or your own organisation for the *Web Site* award.
- You are able to enter another person or another organisation
- Awards must be received by OCV by 5pm on 31 July 2008.
- If one of our judges works for or has a financial interest in your organisation you are not eligible to enter.
